Funds are available through Fillmore County Development Corporation to provide down payment subsidies to homebuyers for the purchase of existing homes within Fillmore County. Eligible applicants would need to meet income qualifications which are 80 percent or lower of the median household incomes of Fillmore County, adjusted for family size. The home must be the principal residence of the buyer. The maximum home loan subsidy will be \$17,000.
